







Memorandum from more than 201 human rights and community organizations from 14 Arab countries to the Nobel Peace Prize Committee demanding not to accept President Trump's nomination

At the initiative of the Moroccan Association for Human Rights, the Jerusalem Center for Legal Aid and Human Rights (Palestine), the Tunisian League for the Defense of Human Rights, the Arab Committee for Human Rights (Paris), the Khiam Center for the Rehabilitation of Victims of Torture (Lebanon), the Algerian League for the Defense of Human Rights and the Amman Center for Human Rights Studies And the Palestine Institute for Security Researches, the following note was prepared on behalf of Arab civil society organizations:

We, the undersigned civil society organizations of various peoples and nationalities in the Arab and Diaspora world express our concern to you about the possibility of awarding President Trump the Nobel Peace Prize, and we recommend not acceptinghis nomination for this award for the following compelling reasons:

- 1. The use of the so-called Israeli, Emirati, Bahraini, American peace agreement, as a pretext for this award is misleading. It is done under American pressure and for electoral reasons concerning both Trump and Netanyahu, and it is an agreement that ignores the rules of international law, consecrates Israeli settlement colonialism, and legitimizes an apartheid system built by Israeli occupation.
- 2. Deciding to withdraw America from the Trans-Pacific Partnership Agreement (January / 2017),
- 3. Withdrawal from the Paris Climate Agreement (June 2017),
- 4. Withdrawal from UNESCO (November 2017),

















- 5. Withdrawal from the US-Iranian friendship agreement signed during the rule of the ousted Shah (May 2018),
- 6. Withdrawal from the Global Postal Service Treaty signed in 1874 and which 192 countries joined (May 2018),
- 7. Withdrawal from the nuclear agreement with Iran (May 2018),
- 8. Withdrawal from the Human Rights Council (June 2018),
- 9. Withdrawal from the Optional Protocol on Conflict Resolution to the Vienna Treaty on Diplomatic Relations (October 2018),
- 10. Withdrawal from the United Nations Weapons Convention (which includes 101 countries) that prohibits the supply of weapons to war criminals (April 2019),
- 11. Withdrawal from the nuclear agreement with Russia (signed in 1987) regarding the deployment of short and medium-range missiles (August 2019),
- 12. The issuance of an executive decision banning entry to visitors from seven Islamic countries, namely Syria, Iran, Iraq, Libya, Somalia, Sudan, and Yemen (1/17/2017),
- 13. Freezing funds to UNRWA (January 2018),
- 14.Stop America's payment of its obligations to the World Health Organization (April 2020),
- 15. Withdrawal from the World Health Organization (July 2020),
- 16. Punish the International Criminal Court for its decision to open an investigation into crimes committed in Afghanistan and Palestine (June 2020),
- 17. His administration's recognition that Jerusalem, in its eastern and western parts, is the capital of Israel (12/6/2017), in contravention of the United Nations resolution to internationalize Jerusalem (issued on November 29, 1947), which prompted the Security Council to adopt a resolution rejecting Trump's declaration (12/18/2017) / 2017),
- 18. Failure to fulfill his promise to withdraw the American forces that have occupied parts of Syrian territory since 2015 (April 2018),

















- 19. His declaration of a decree recognizing Israel's annexation of the occupied Golan in 1967, in violation of Security Council Resolutions No. 242 of 11/22/1967 and 497 of 12/17/1981 (3/25/2019),
- 20. The practice of extortion and financial piracy by his public demands for many countries friends to America to pay billions of dollars in exchange for protection for those in power (his claims repeatedly to Saudi Arabia as a model) (October 2018, May 2019, etc.),
- 21. Continuing the policy of imposing economic sanctions on countries, companies, and individuals from various countries of the world,
- 22.In one hour, he launched he gave a discriminatory description of Covid 19 as "the Chinese virus" (March 17, 2020),
- 23.Demonstrating racism over the killing of George Floyd by refusing to condemn the rampant police violence against black citizens in America (from May 25, 2020 until now). The US House of Representatives described Trump's comments on Twitter as "racist" and that it "legitimized and increased fear and hatred towards new Americans and people of color."
- 24. Using the humanitarian crises in Sudan to draw it towards recognizing Israeli and the deal of the century aimed at liquidating the Palestinian cause, and setting that as a condition for removing Sudan from the lists of terrorism, and this confirms the use of "combating terrorism" as a tool to subjugate states and peoples and to issue decisions inconsistent with the principles of international law.

Therefore, in light of the foregoing, the signatory organizations, which denounce the positions of President Trump, which are deeply racist and advocate hatred on the basis of race and religion, and which feed the tendency of wars and the appropriation of peoples' capabilities, lack of respect for international law and the granting of what he does not possess to those who do not deserve, and give priority to the interests of the circles of wild capital over people's rights in a clean environment and sustainable development, these organizations demand the Nobel Peace Prize Committee not to accept Trump's candidacy for them.
